Our History

Great Lakes Bay Health Centers (formerly Health Delivery, Inc.) began as a very small migrant health clinic in 1968, when the Saginaw County Health Department received a \$75,000 grant to provide health care to farm workers. Today, Great Lakes Bay Health Centers is the largest of the 42 Michigan Health Center organizations.

These Michigan Health Centers operate over 250 sites across the state and help more than 615,000 patients each year access quality, comprehensive, affordable health care, regardless of insurance status or income level.

We offer prevention and treatment for HIV. This includes medical care, an onsite laboratory, medication, insurance, testing, transportation assistance, and other supportive services.

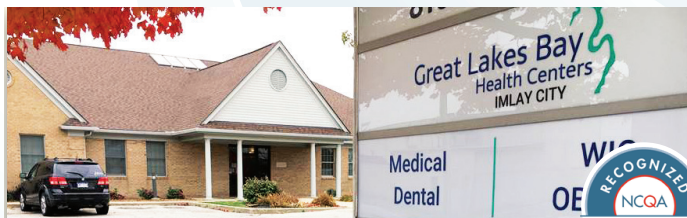

School-Based Health Centers

- *Integrated at school locations and open to students ages 5-21. This allows for consistent and convenient medical services - including everything from sports physicals and well-child visits to treatment of illness, injuries or chronic conditions to counseling and health education. This approach helps to ensure the best care possible for the students - right in their school.*
- *Parental consent is required for all services (except Adolescent Confidential Health Services as per Michigan law).*
- *Students or parents may call and make appointments or stop by the health center to make an appointment.*

SERVICES PROVIDED: Annual/Sports Physicals, Treatment for Illness or Injuries, Health Education, Vaccines (Shots), Behavioral Health Counseling, TB Tests, Lab Tests, Dental Bus, Medicaid Enrollment, Confidential Testing and more.

NOTE: NO birth control pills, condoms or devices prescribed; NO abortion services, counseling or referrals for abortion services will be provided.

Migrant farm workers have little, if any, access to health care or medication. Language and cultural barriers also prevent migrant farm workers from obtaining care or services. We were founded upon providing health care for farm workers, and we keep this a priority today. 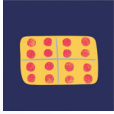
